Our area tryouts will be held on January 12, 2019 at Clements High School. The address is 4200 Elkins Rd, Sugar Land, TX 77479

You will need to be in the main commons by 10:15 AM. Each section will be called to go to their room at the appropriate time. There will be posted schedules if there are multiple instruments auditioning in your room. The times are approximate and it is YOUR responsibility to listen for your instrument to be called.

If you are unable to attend the Area tryouts, we must call the alternate. Notify your band director ASAP if you will not be attending.

Be on time!! Late arrivals will not be accommodated, unless there is a valid reason. Late students may only enter late until the first round of playing has been completed. After the first round is completed no students will be allowed into the audition for any reason.

The area fee that you will pay at your region tryouts is **\$7.00**. Students that qualify for State will need to pay the State fee of **\$20.00** at the conclusion of their Area audition. Please be prepared to fill out all the necessary forms for state if you make it.

- Make sure you discuss the warm-up procedure with your director.
- Do not wear letter jackets or clothing that may identify your school affiliation.
- Absolutely no electronic or recording devices will be allowed in the tryout rooms. This includes ipods, tablets, cd players, games or gaming devices, recording devices, cell phones, computers, etc. If in doubt, ask.
- Metronome markings should be observed.
- A non-audible single use metronome may be used prior to the performance, but not during the performance. Tuners and/or metronome tuners are not allowed in the audition room.
