All warming up is to be done in the Practice Gym and students should remain in the practice gym until their performance. Students are asked to report to their performance room no more than 10 minutes prior to their scheduled time. Out of consideration of performers, no playing will be allowed in the hallways. Monitors and guides will be available to assist you and your students.

Concessions will be located in the Gym and all food must remain in the gym. Lunch will be provided for directors and judges in the Teacher's Lounge.

Parking will be available in the student parking lot on 13th street, located diagonally from the football field and just east of the school.

Please have your students enter the building through the gate on 13th street, leading to the fine arts/gym entrance. We ask that your students move quietly to the gym as they will be moving passed several performance areas.

Although standard percussion equipment will be available, students should be prepared to bring their own sticks and/or mallets. Performance risers will be available for ensembles in the auditorium. If you are bringing equipment that requires large doors, be prepared to enter the building through the rear service entrance on 14th street. Please let us know in advance if you are bringing any large instruments, so that we can comfortably accommodate you. Greeters will be located outside of the building at the front gate and rear service entrance.
